Top Five: Truck Driver Factor Indicators of Future Likelihood of Crash Involvement

While some of these percentages have changed with new studies by ATRI, they remain incredibly consistent. Don't become part of a statistic.

The safety of you and everyone else on the roads is most important!

Driver Factors	Percentage increase for likelihood of future crash Involvement
1) A Reckless Driving Violation	325% Increase
2) An Improper Turn Violation	105% Increase
3) An Improper/Erratic Lane Change (Conviction)	100% Increase
A Failure to Yield Right-of-Way (Conviction)	97% Increase
5) A Failure to maintain Proper Lane (Conviction)	91% Increase
