This year's International Roadcheck inspection blitz is on the books for **May 4-6, 2021** focusing in on:

Hours-of-Service & Vehicle Lighting

Inoperable lamps was the #1 vehicle violation in 2020. Inspectors will also focus in on other areas like brake systems, exhaust systems, steering mechanisms, tires, wheels, wipers, etc.

Do You Know What a CVSA Decal Means?

Vehicles that successfully pass a Level I or V inspection during the blitz will receive a CVSA decal. *In general, vehicles with a CVSA decal are not re-inspected during the three-month period during which the decal is valid.* Think about that one as we prepare for this International Blitz. Be prepared!

New Crash Tests Show Modest Speed Increases Can Have Deadly Consequences

If you are reading the monthly safety bulletins, which we hope you are, you've surely noticed Speed has been and will continue to be a hot topic.

It has been reported that even small speed increases can have major effects on crash outcomes. We already know speed is the #1 cause of crashes.

41 states allow 70 mph or higher speeds on some roadways including eight states that have maximum speeds of 80 mph or more. NOT FOR US! It's too risky for what we do. A speeding driver *may* arrive at their destination a few minutes faster but is the tradeoff of getting severely injured or even losing one's life worth it if that crash occurs?? Nope!
